We will have a one day dig at the Sharpes Emerald Prospect in Hiddenite, NC. This is our new mine. The club was in one day during the roundup. Specimens found included gem grade muscovite mica, green and blue beryl, smoky quartz crystals and cutting grade smoky quartz. We will have a machine in prior to the dig to open new areas.
